2. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH all the clothing jewellery watches and other  
articles of personal wear or adornment owned by me at the date of my death to my  
niece LOUIE ELIZABETH SHARPE of Herald Street, Wellington, to be divided amongst  
such of my relatives as are living at my death in such manner and for such one or  
more of them exclusively of the other or others of them as my said niece thinks  
fit. I DIRECT that the receipt of my said niece for the said articles shall be  
an absolute discharge to my Trustee who shall not be concerned with the  
distribution or destination of the same.

3. I GIVE AND DEVISE my dwelling situate at and known as Number 210  
Bealey Avenue, Christchurch, to my nephew WILLIAM ALFRED HOLLINGSHEAD SHARPE  
(the eldest son of my deceased brother William Alfred Sharpe) absolutely.

4. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the residue of my estate to my Trustee  
UPON TRUST to pay my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses including  
all estate and succession duty payable on any part of my estate and to stand  
possessed of the balance for such of them DULCIE KEYS, ROY SHARPE, KENNETH  
SHARPE and the said Louie Elizabeth Sharpe (the children of my said deceased  
brother William Alfred Sharpe) as survive me and if more than one in equal  
shares.

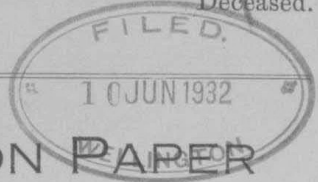
